Requirements to Become a Member of the AARA

- »Generate the majority of your annual income from providing roofing services
 - »Have a regional business license, including a city business license for a minimum of five years.
 - » Pay a one time initiation fee (contractors only)
 - » Be COR or SECOR certified. (If not, begin the process and send documents to prove so. Will need to be completed within the 1 year probationary period
- »Carry a minimum of two million dollars liability insurance that will be annually reviewed and verified
- »Torch-On Insurance coverage that will be annually reviewed and verified(if applicable)
 - »A valid WCB number that will be annually reviewed and verified
- »Install to the current Alberta Building Code as a minimum standard
- »Have addressed and resolved all customer complaints made to the Association Office or to the Better Business Bureau
- »For Contractors: The AARA will conduct project observations, to determine if your workmanship meets Alberta Building Code. We will require a list of 3-5 active projects that a certified inspector from our association will do 2 unannounced inspections.

How to Apply

If your company fulfills the required credentials:

- »An application must be filled out and sent to aara@albertaroofting.com
- »A meeting will be scheduled with the appropriate board members of the AARA members to initiate the application.
- »A Board member will then contact you to update you on the application status.
